- Attach the documents you would like to print to an email and send it to:
  - solomonwrightprinter@gmail.com
- You will receive a reply email containing a print release code.
- Visit the library to enter your code into our printer and print your documents.
- For curbside service, call the library and let us know your code. We will print your documents and place them in a sealed bag on our curbside cart for pickup.

You can also bring a USB stick with you to the library and plug it directly into our printer to bypass the email process.




### May 22: Bee Keeping
